

## 2017-2018 Tuition Update

We listened to your ideas. Based on our school wide survey results, we have changed to a new tuition template for the 2017-2018 school year. Many stakeholders were interested in moving to an all inclusive “one figure” for tuition. This new one figure format embeds the historical extra fees: Text/resource fee, Facility Fee, Art fee (K-8), Class Dues (6-12), Annual Leadership Retreat (9-12). This allows our families to spread these extra fees across the 12 month payment plan instead of having to pay the entire fee all at once. A couple of fees still remain outside this format as they are “participation only” fees ie. National Honor Society, Leadership Academy, Athletics, School productions.

If you have one child, you will pay the 1<sup>st</sup> student column amount according to the Grade Level of your child.

Plan	Due Date	Families who choose the <b>1 payment plan</b> will receive a <b>\$75 credit to their account</b> . Those choosing the <b>2 payment plan</b> will receive a <b>\$50 credit to their account</b> . <b>A 25.00 Fee will be charged to change any payment plan once it has been submitted.</b> Withdrawal fee: Pre-K: \$200; Kindergarten: \$350; Grades 1-12: \$500. (Paid if withdrawal occurs after May 1 and after 30 days of commitment)
1 Payment Plan	July 1	
2 Payment Plan	July 1 and February 1	
12 Payment plan	1 <sup>st</sup> of every month	

Families with multiple children will pay the 1<sup>st</sup> student column for the first child followed by the 2<sup>nd</sup> student column according to grade level for 2<sup>nd</sup> child, followed by the 3<sup>rd</sup> student column according to grade level for the 3<sup>rd</sup> child and so forth. Below is an example of a family of three with students in High School, Middle School, and Elementary. Always start with your oldest child and move to your youngest child.
