### **GPA Computation & Credits:**

The grade point average is the equivalent GPA quality points divided by the number of yearly credits. While GPA is updated each semester, only yearly averages are used in the calculation.

AP denotes Advanced Placement and receives 1.5 extra quality points. Additionally, CCP/Dual Enrollment College courses receive 1.0 extra quality point, while Honors courses receive a 0.5 extra quality point.

FCS uses a 10-point grading scale. Given the small class sizes, academic strength of students, narrow range of grades, and rigorous college preparatory curriculum, FCS does not rank its students. The Valedictorian and Salutatorian are the only ranks designated.

Credits to graduate include the following (26 units TOTAL):
